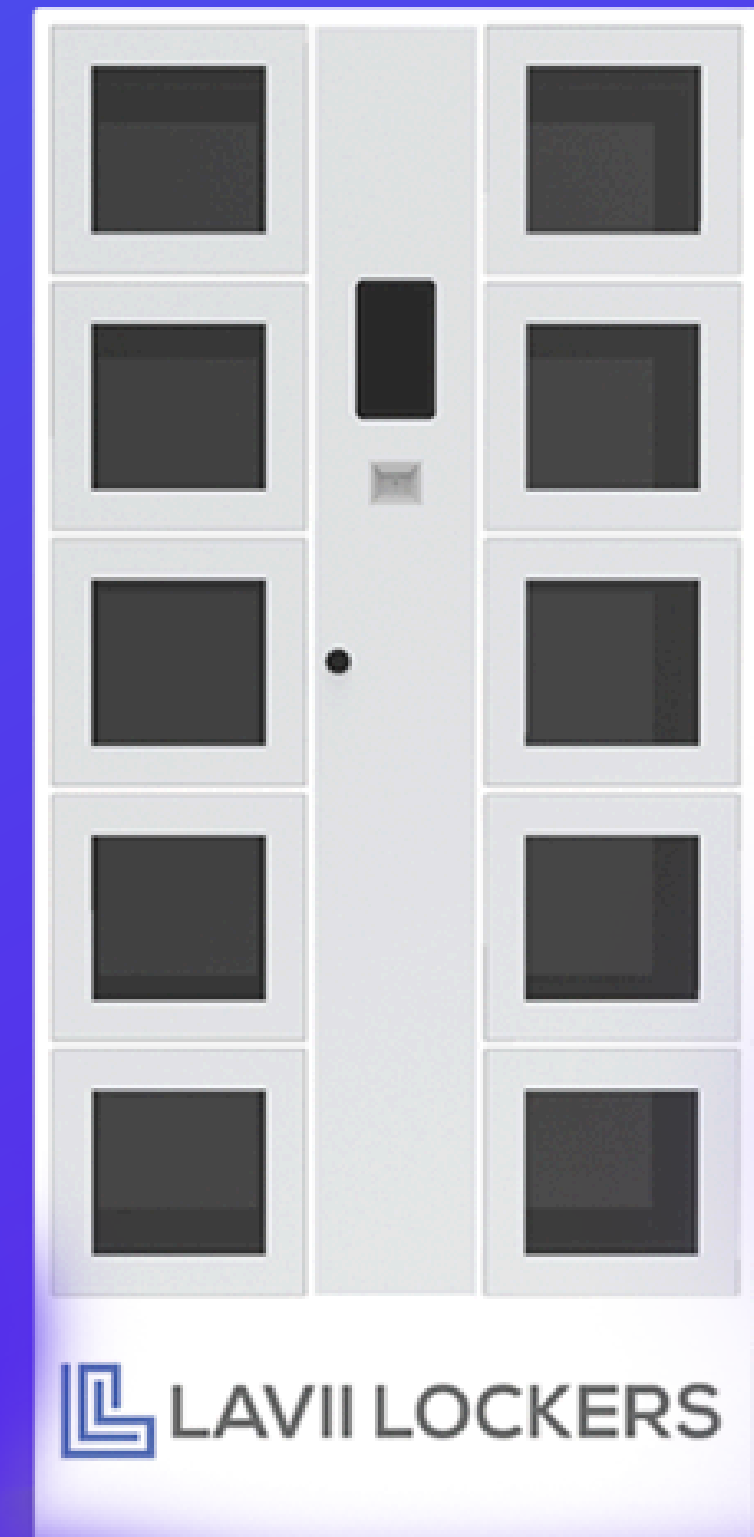
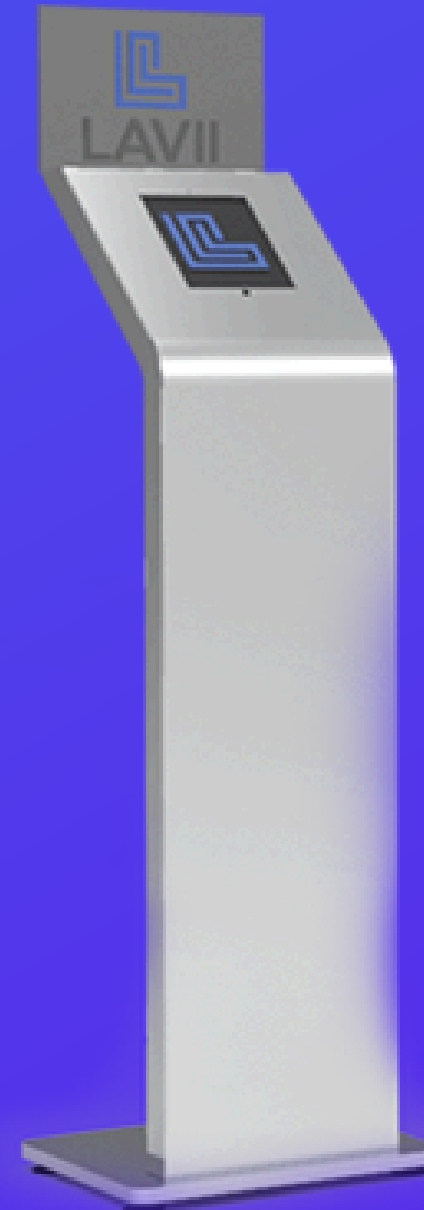

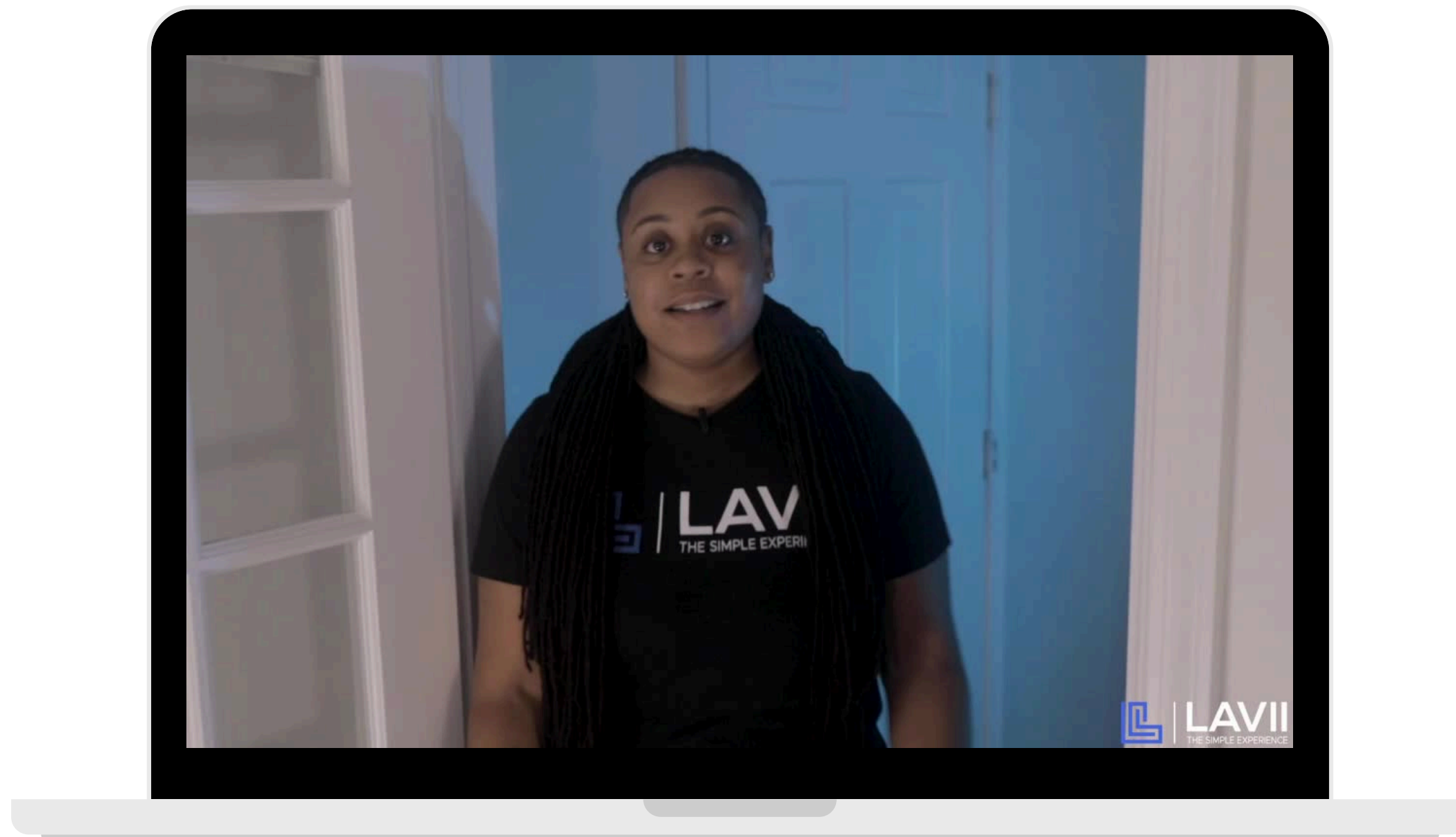

Customer Places Order

Customer places order through restaurant's online order system.

"Order Ready" Message Received

This message contains QR code needed to open locker

Order is Picked Up!

Customer's QR Code is used to open the locker and retrieve the order.

Restaurant Journey

1 Receives Order

Restaurant receives the order via it's Point-Of-Sale System (POS). Restaurant begins cooking and preparing food for pickup.

2 Selects Locker For Order Placement

Using tablet, restaurant selects locker(s) they would like the order to be placed in.

3 Places Order In Locker

Restaurant places the order in the locker(s) selected and closes the door(s).

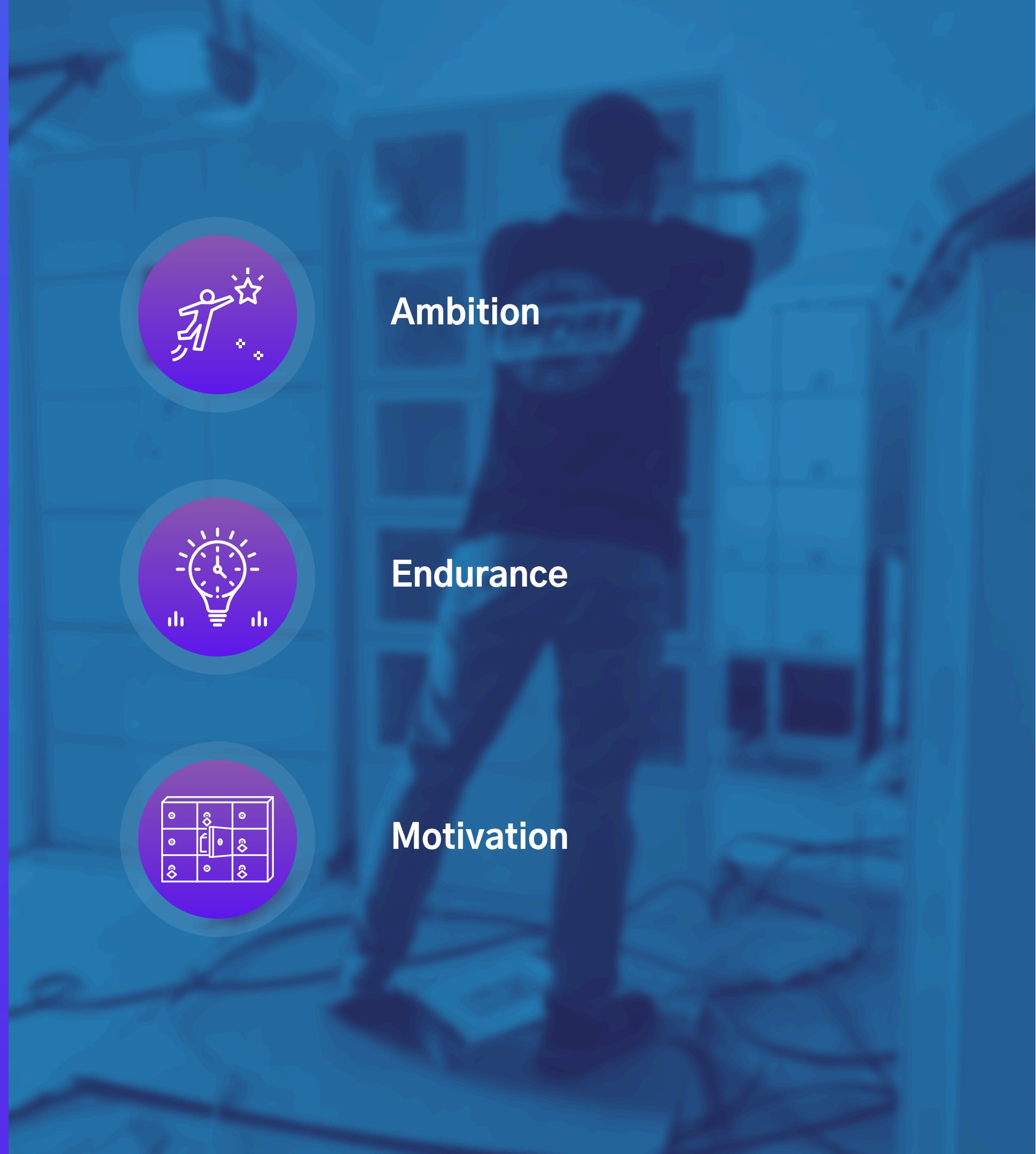

"I take all that stuff and use it as fuel."

"Growing up I was always different. I recall taking apart my Playstation and putting it back together just to understand how it works."

"I'm almost always either the only female or the only black person. Sometimes I get overlooked and disrespected, but I take all that stuff and use it as fuel to succeed. I've always done male-dominated things like play basketball, and I'm a drummer"

"The fact that I'm black, I'm a woman, and I'm gay I think that makes it even more difficult. I'm proud to hold space in tech for groups marginalized far too often."

"Even when I go on platforms that support women in tech, I still do not look like those women. They still promote these glammed up-- and is nothing wrong with it, but glammed up women in high heels and dresses, and that's not me. So I still feel like there's a barrier and a gap between different kinds of women and different kinds of personalities and just different things about women in general that shouldn't be generalized."

"I wanted to be a lawyer and play basketball in the NBA, until senior year of high school."

"Being a black man in tech, or just a black man in general, it's not a lot of us. There are a lot of opportunities in developing so I've never felt like I was overlooked or anything, but you just always notice that when you start your new job there are not a lot of us at all."

"Growing up in a certain environment, your first thought-- especially if you're a male, is sports. 'I want to make the NBA or I want to make the NFL,' because some of the other things, like being a doctor or lawyer, may seem daunting or out of reach."

"It's good for us to champion blacks in tech because now other people can see that there's another way to make pretty good money. To make a living for yourself and do very well in a growing field that has plenty of opportunities."

"I feel like God has shown me heaven sent strategy."

"I kind of stumbled into the tech space. I was not doing well in college at first, but it just so happened that everybody knew that I drew. The art aspect and realizing that tech wasn't as hard as I thought it was is what made me fall in love with web design. I can't see myself doing anything else now."

"Even in our program at Bowie State University, you saw whites and Asians kind of excelling. I think those professors sensed that we, as African-Americans, were being left behind. So, I feel like they pushed us harder there than the average professor would have pushed anybody in any other school."

"A lot of what we did for Lavii from a technical standpoint are things that like I've never done before. When I hit roadblocks, I stop everything I'm doing and just pray and ask God for help. When I go to sleep, the next day I will wake up with an incredible epiphany. I lie to you not! It's happened like 10 times, to the point where I can count on that process now."

"I felt like God has shown me a super simple way to get this accomplished using a lot of like cutting edge technologies and just like heaven sent strategy."
